# 1. THE GOALS OF VISION FRANCE

## General goals

Vision France aims to plant new churches that are a living testimony to the region, in response to the Lord's command to, "go into all the World and preach the gospel." Presently we have fifteen churches within the Alsace-Moselle region, three church-planting teams in Jura and neighbouring regions and two in Vendée.

These newly-founded churches will be autonomous in their leadership, self propagating and financial independent. They will express their faith according to biblical principals within contemporary French culture.

Vision France aims to mobilize Christians in order to plant new evangelical churches, to promote an effective testimony of the Gospel within France.



## Specific goals up to 2012

- ◆ That the churches in Lons-le-Saunier, Oyonnax and Besançon become independent
- ◆ The planting of two more churches in Jura
- ◆ The planting of two more churches in Vendée
- ◆ The planting of one church in Strasbourg the capital of Europe

## 2. THE NEEDS OF VISION FRANCE

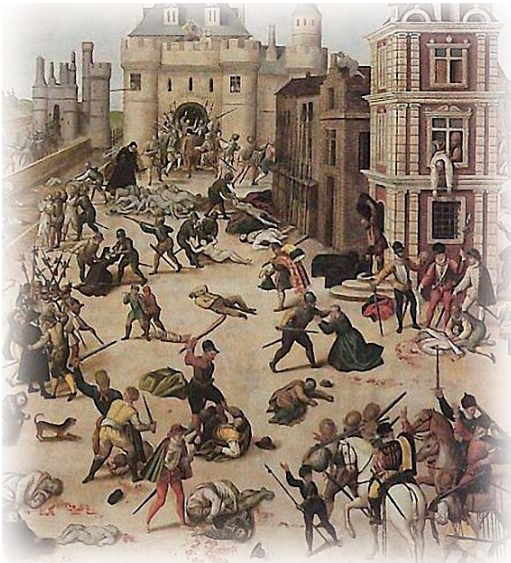
### Workers

- ◆ Two new church-planting teams for Jura
- ◆ Two new church-planting teams for Vendée
- ◆ One new church-planting team for Strasbourg
- ◆ Plus volunteers and tent-makers who will assist the church-planting teams

### Finances

We depend on our Lord Jesus Christ for our financial support. Nevertheless we are also looking for supporters such as private persons, churches, missionary societies who will support our fellow workers in evangelism and mission. Each missionary will have to raise at least 80% of his support before he is allowed to begin to work. As far as possible, Vision France will subsidise the rest of the support.

### Spiritual Support



This former Christian nation is in dire need of a new spiritual awakening. Spiritual strongholds need to be overcome: the persecution of the Huguenots; the deification of humanism; widespread occult practices. Pray for a biblical, home-grown faith; deliverance from spiritual bondages; a God-given vision for our existing churches to be missional. Our oldest churches are the fruit of the awakening movement in the 19th century.

### 3. THE RELATIONSHIPS OF VISION FRANCE

Chrischona, as a theological center, has sent missionaries to all parts of the world – in the beginning, especially to the USA, France, Israel and Palestine. In the beginning stages, Chrischona was inspired by the



Keswick movement and received financial help from different countries. We still recruit missionaries from the Theological Seminary St. Chrischona, as well as from other schools.

- ◆ Vision France is a member of the national Fédération Evangélique de France (FEF).
- ◆ Vision France works in partnership with the Commission d'Implantation d'Eglises Nouvelles (CIEN) of the FEF.
- ◆ Vision France seeks to initiate and develop partnerships throughout the world for the spreading of the Gospel in France.
- ◆ Vision France supports the development of a global vision for the evangelical churches in France.
- ◆ Vision France fosters the missionary vision of the Pilgermission St. Chrischona.
- ◆ Vision France supports local churches in the planting of daughter churches.
